





World Data System (WDS)

- Interdisciplinary Body of ICSU (International Council for Science).
- Created through decision of 29th GA of ICSU.



- Builds on 50-year legacy of WDCs (World Data Centers) and FAGS.
- The WDS concept aims at a transition from existing standalone WDCs and individual Services to a common globally interoperable distributed data system, that incorporates emerging technologies and new scientific data activities.
- WDS will strive to become a worldwide 'community of excellence' for scientific data.
- NICT hosts the IPO (International Programme Office).
- IVS accepted as member pending signing an agreement with ICSU WDS (formally obligating the IVS).
